Are you a business person? Can you help us create a structure to oversee ongoing operational income and expenses? Do you have income generation ideas?


Are you a storage/organization wizard? Can you help us organize materials so the building serves people smoothly?

Give to Lincoln Day is right around the corner. Transformations Thrift Store is one non-profit that relies heavily on the donations we receive from Give To Lincoln Day to carry us through the year. That looks like providing information about Celebrate Recovery, and other recovery programs, Atlas:Lincoln, Food Net and local church homes - because we know the neighborhood and they know us.
