JUST LIKE US: A STUDY OF THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF ELIJAH THE PROPHET

On Sunday, September 17th we are planning to start a new sermon series for our F Street Church family that will examine what we can learn from the life and ministry of the Old Testament prophet named Elijah. In the dust cover of his book titled, <u>Elijah: A Man of Heroism and Humility</u>, author Charles Swindoll, has written:

"Exploring the depths of Elijah's fascinating life as prophet of God...

[we are presented with] an honest picture of this ordinary man who God transformed into His personal spokesman to confront idolatry and evil in the ancient world. ...In a world that has lost its way, due in part to the lack of balanced, godly leadership, we are more than ever in need of a few Elijah-like men and women who are not afraid to live courageously among their peers as they walk humbly with God."

It is our hope that this series will accomplish that purpose in our congregation.

QPR Training

QPR Suicide Prevention Training is an evidence-based approach so people like us can learn to prevent someone from taking their own life. It has already saved hundreds of lives. It is like the life-saving CPR training that many of us have learned, though not nearly so intense and much shorter. In QPR ordinary people learn to ask the QUESTION about whether a person is considering suicide, PERSUADE the person that their death would make a difference and then REFER them to the 988 hotline or other professional help.

School Community Intervention and Prevention, Region 5 Prevention
Systems and churches from across
Lancaster County are teaming up to provide this free training to hundreds of us. This national program has proven to make a life-saving difference.
